For ALL grants awarded to my district, I will ensure 100% of project reports are submitted on time to LCIF to remain in good standing for future funding.

I will appoint four (4) Lions in the District as support persons to the District GST Coordinator. These four will follow up clubs with problems of navigating MyLion/MyLCI and enter reports on their behalf whilst continuing to train them.
