LEADERSHIP: CLUB OFFICER TRAINING

In the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 80% of incoming Club Officers will complete Club Officer training.

Action Items:

- I will ensure that my district team understands their roles in the Club Officer training process .
- I will encourage the District GLT Coordinator to include Club Officer training in the GAT development plan and to report the completed training.
- I will support and promote Club Officer learning events.

Additional action items to achieve this goal:

I have a two member GLT with a retired superintendent of education leading the training cause and mentor ID Ardie Klemish to make sure he understands his role better. My other member is a Lion that is being mentor into cabinet functions in the Leadership Team to have more hands and feet to reach more officers in training . He is a former educator that understands educating leaders. Likewise, as an educator, I will be out and about contacting officers to be trained especially if not entering on MyLCI and MyLion as well as checking to see who is and isn't trained. To reach 80% my team will need to reach out on a 1-1 basis to bring that to reality.

REGION AND ZONE CHAIRPERSON TRAINING

In the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 100% of incoming Region and Zone Chairpersons will complete Region and Zone Chairperson training.

Action Items:

- I will ensure that my district team understands their roles in the Region and Zone Chairperson training process.
- I will encourage my District GLT Coordinator to include Region and Zone Chairperson training in the GAT development plan and to report the completed training.
- I will support and promote Region/Zone Chairperson training events.

Additional action items to achieve this goal:

9SW is moving the zone chairs to establish a new and large activity city with Lions and non-Lions in their zone to carry out in one of the 5 areas that LCI is promoting from stride walks and hunger approach. In addition, zone chairs will alert district governor and GAT team to any red areas on their reports so the team can then notify club and try to offer help in training and all to improve their red areas whether it is membership , leadership or activities. All clubs will be monitor to see if they are achieving club Excellence in growth, in training and in activities.

LEARNING FOR EVERY LION

Lions Leadership institutes

During the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the district will identify 4 qualified candidates to apply for local and Lions Clubs International sponsored institutes in our area.

Action Items:

- I will ensure my district team understands their role in identifying qualified candidates for institutes.

Custom goal and action items

Currently 9SW is training secretaries and service chairs on the new program.

SERVICE: PEOPLE SERVED

In the 2019-2020 fiscal year, my district will serve 20000 people.

Action Items:

For this goal, 9SW struggles as so many clubs have not put all their activities on or none. My goal is more about growth for as growth happens activity will increase and the other part is to increase the number reporting to eventually 100% but will need to find new members in 4 clubs that have smart phones or email accounts. Then add those members to those clubs with them allowing the new members to be service chairs.

SERVICE ACTIVITIES

Action Items:

I will educate clubs in my district about our global causes.

SERVICE ACTIVITY REPORTING

In the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 85 % of clubs in my district will report their service projects via MyLion Web or MyLCI.

Action Items:

My District GAT Coordinators will organize MyLion Web reporting training and provide the Why Service Reporting Matters document to attendees.

I will encourage all members (or all Club Presidents) in my district to download the MyLion app and use it for all service projects.

I will ensure the Global Action Team continues to support clubs in reporting.

I will emphasize the responsibility of the Club Service Charis to report their clubs service.

My district will use and promote service resources to achieve our goal (i.e. Service Activity Reporting, Service Reporting Guide, and Why Service Reporting Matters).

Additional action items to achieve this goal:

9SW Zone Chairs will be asked to organize and carry out an activity tied to one of the 5 areas with Lions and non-Lions participating as well as at our 9SW convention and our new spring event 9SW GALA for achieving and surpassing some goals. To ensure better activities and more activities in smaller clubs, 9SW is pushing to have 75% of the clubs achieve CLUB EXCELLENCE PATCH. If 9SW makes that goal of the clubs, then most of the other goals will fall in place.

LCIF: PARTICIPATE

By the end of the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 40% of Lions in my district will understand the impact of our Foundation and demonstrate their support with a donation to LCIF.

Action Items:

I will support my LCIF District Coordinator to educate Lions about LCIF and maximize participation of Lions in Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering Service.

My district will promote members giving \$2 each week to Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering Service.

FUNDRAISE

During the 2019-2020 fiscal year, I will partner with our LCIF District Coordinator to raise US\$ 22000.00 to support Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering Service.

Action Items:

My district will raise US\$ 5000.00 to support Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering Service.

My district will secure 1 Model Club commitments for Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering service.

My district will recruit 2 100/100 Clubs this year

ADVOCATE

In the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 90% of clubs in my district will report their service projects via MyLion Web or MyLCI.

Action Items:

My district will educate our Lions about the expanded global causes for LCIF and grant opportunities available to us.

I will include messaging about LCIF in every visit I make as District Governor

For ALL grants awarded to my district, I will ensure 100% of project reports are submitted on time to LCIF to remain in good standing for future funding

The GAT team will be informed by Zone Chairs to which clubs have failed to report activities. The GAT team will contact service chairs or secretaries to see if training is needed. If so, that training will be promptly delivered to that secretary or service chair.

Custom goal and action items

9SW will promote all aspects of LCIF to its members at each club visit and through mailings to club members when possible.

Zone Chairs will also be instructed and asked to model giving to LCIF Campaign 100 as well as other members of 9 SW Team...
