## Goal Statement

Club Members of District 14B will participate in an assembly of Giving Backpacks for the homeless of Allegheny County. The items in the Backpacks will be either donated by area businesses or purchased using funds applied for from the McKeesport Hospital Foundation and other area Foundations.

The Giving Backpacks Project happened on Saturday, November 13, 2021, at the Western PA School for Blind Children in Oakland, PA.
